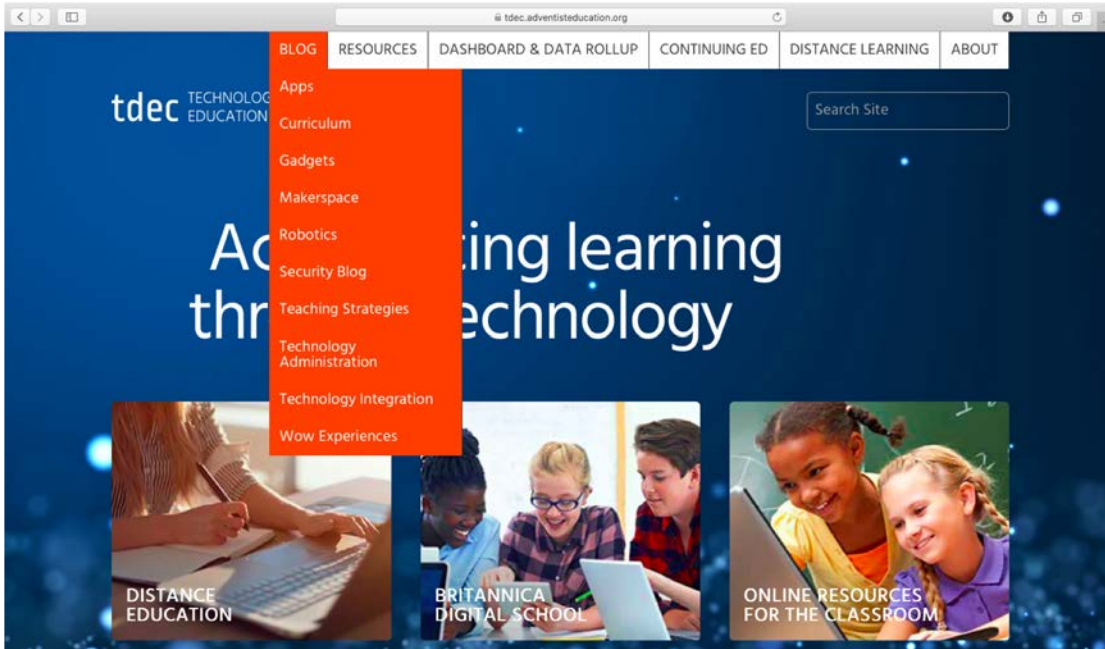

- Many enhancements to Opening Report/Summary

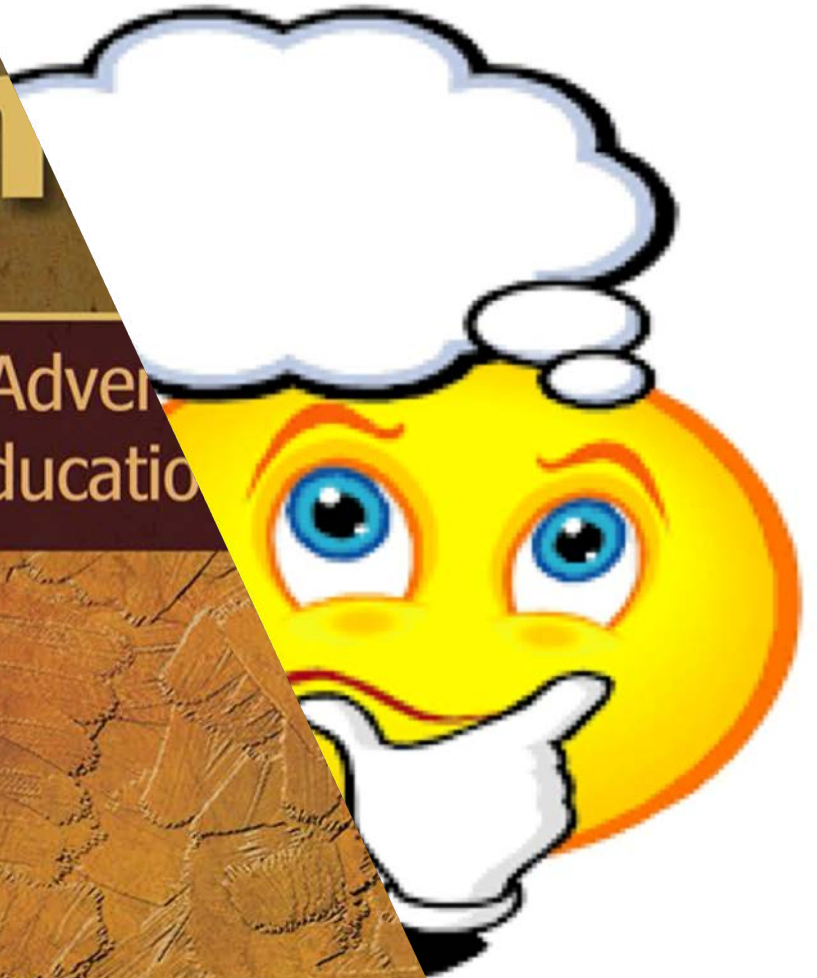

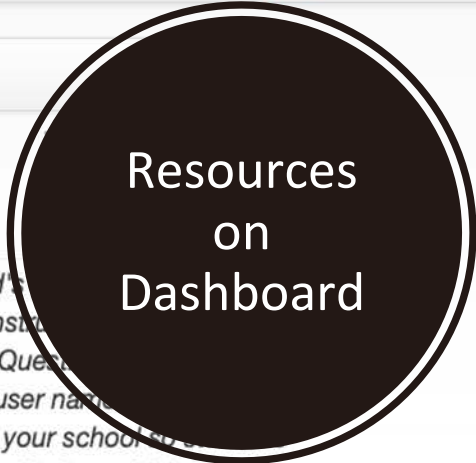
